

The California Private Postsecondary Education Act (CPPEA) of 2009, effective January 1, 2010, requires under section 94910 of the Act that a school provide completion and placement rate information, licensure exam pass rate information, and salary/wage information for each program offered by the school. The following information is data compiled from January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010.

Available for Graduation: The number of students who began program minus the number of “Students unavailable for graduation,” which means those students who have died, been incarcerated, or called to active military duty.

Graduates: The number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length.

Completion Rate: The number of Graduates divided by the Number of Students Available for Graduation.

Students Taking Exam: The number of students who completed the program within 150% of published program length and for whom the reported exam is the first exam that was available after their completion of the program.

Exam Date: The date for the first available exam after the students completed the program.

Pass Rate: Calculated by dividing the number of students who pass the exam by the number of graduates who take the reported licensing exam.

Graduates Available for Employment: The number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment. “Graduates unavailable for employment” means graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.

Graduates Employed in the Field: Graduates who report that they are gainfully employed within six months of graduation in a position for which the skills obtained through the education and training provided by the institution are required or provided a significant advantage to the graduate in obtaining the position.

Placement Rate: Calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
